## 10 DAY FAST JANUARY 8 - 17

The ALC 10-Day Fast for January 8-17, 2026 is a spiritual journey into REHOBOTH— “The Lord has made room for us, and we will flourish in the land.” (Genesis 26:22).

As we begin this new season, God is calling us beyond survival, beyond contention, and beyond limitation into a wide open space of divine rest, peace, and fruitfulness.

This fast is about digging again, letting go of old battles, trusting God through opposition, and positioning ourselves for overflow without struggle. As Isaac moved from famine to favor, so shall we.

# DAY 1 - A CALL TO REHOBOTH

Entering God's Wide Open Space

## SCRIPTURE

- Genesis 26:22
- Psalm 66:12

## PRAYER POINTS

- Thank God for bringing you out of restriction and pressure.
- Declare that God is making room for you spiritually, emotionally, and practically.
- Ask God to open your eyes to the season you are stepping into.



# DAY 2 - OBEDIENCE IN THE FAMINE

Staying Where God Planted You

## SCRIPTURE

- Genesis 26:1-3
- Isaiah 1:19

## PRAYER POINTS

- Ask for grace to obey God even when circumstances are uncomfortable.
- Pray against panic-driven decisions.
- Declare that obedience will lead you into increase.





# DAY 3 - DIGGING AGAIN

Restoring What Was Covered

## SCRIPTURE

- Genesis 26:18
- Joel 2:25

## PRAYER POINTS

- Ask God to restore spiritual wells that were neglected or blocked.
- Pray for renewed passion for prayer, word, and worship.
- Declare restoration of lost time and momentum.





# DAY 4 - WALKING AWAY FROM STRIFE

The Power of Letting Go

## SCRIPTURE

- Genesis 26:20
- Romans 12:18

## PRAYER POINTS

- Ask God for grace to release conflict and offense.
- Pray for freedom from bitterness and retaliation.
- Declare peace as your posture and strength.



# DAY 5 - ENDURING OPPOSITION

Trusting God When Doors Close

## SCRIPTURE

- Genesis 26:21
- James 1:2

## PRAYER POINTS

- Ask for strength to persevere without discouragement
- Pray against weariness of soul.
- Declare that opposition will not abort your promise.





# DAY 6 - DIG ONE MORE WELL

Refusing to Quit

## SCRIPTURE

- Galatians 6:9
- Hebrews 10:35–36

## PRAYER POINTS

- Ask God for renewed courage to try again.
- Pray against settling for less than God's best.
- Declare divine stamina and faith for the next step.





# DAY 7 - REHOBOTH: GOD MAKES ROOM

Overflow Without Struggle

## SCRIPTURE

- Genesis 26:22
- Psalm 23:5

## PRAYER POINTS

- Thank God for the season of ease and expansion.
- Declare abundance without contention.
- Pray for peace that preserves prosperity.



# DAY 8 - FRUITFULNESS IN THE LAND

Flourishing Where You Are

## SCRIPTURE

- Genesis 26:12
- Psalm 92:12-14

## PRAYER POINTS

- Ask God to multiply your efforts and results.
- Pray for fruitfulness in work, family, and ministry.
- Declare a hundredfold return by God's hand.





# DAY 9 -REST FROM ENEMIES

God Fights for You

## SCRIPTURE

- Exodus 14:14
- Psalm 110:1

## PRAYER POINTS

- Thank God for divine vindication.
- Pray for rest from opposition and spiritual warfare.
- Declare that God is silencing resistance on your behalf.





# DAY 10 - LIVING IN THE WIDE OPEN SPACE

Sustaining the Rehoboth Life

## SCRIPTURE

- Isaiah 54:2-3
- Ephesians 3:20

## PRAYER POINTS

- Ask God to help you steward expansion wisely.
- Pray for humility, gratitude, and faithfulness.
- Declare that this season will be sustained and multiplied.



# CLOSING DECLARATION

Father, we thank You for leading us into Rehoboth.

We receive room to grow, peace to flourish, and grace to abound.

We receive grace to dig again despite contention and opposition. We declare that the wells of strife are behind us, and the wide open space of Your promise is before us.
